One would be hard-pressed to find a more high profile location than the iconic New York Stock Exchange building that inherently functions as a symbol of the heart of American capitalism in the center of New York City. The NYSE is a 226-year old institution of vast cultural importance whose profile could not be higher. So, when NYSE wanted to restore the illusion of outdoor lighting from otherwise obscured interior windows and a huge ceiling inside the structure, their reliance on EOS Light to get the job done right was a true honor and a privilege.

The bulk of the job consisted of using both the EOS Light Basic LightPanel System and Custom LightPanel Solution to backlight a ceiling to simulate what was once an actual skylight. The use of thin, consistently and uniformly bright EOS LightPanels overhead was a creative way to restore the appearance of natural light coming through ceiling glass (that had been covered up from above many years ago). The same held true for several interior side windows that once led out to a courtyard and needed to appear as though natural light was shining through.






1920s original natural light
